Why, yes! Of course we welcome children at Reunion!

We also know that you want grown-up time with your friends —so in addition to hosting child-friendly events such as the Fun-in-the-Sun Carnival, we also offer you a variety of child-care options.

For Children 6 to 15 years: the university sponsored Youth Program on Friday and Saturday is available from 4:00–11:00 p.m. Dinner will be provided.

For Children 12 weeks to 10 years: evening childcare is available at the Ithaca Community Childcare Center from 6:00–11:00 p.m.

Please note that when you register your children with your class registration, they will **NOT** automatically be registered for either of these two options. Separate pre-registration is **required** for both programs. Deadline is May 27. For details and registration, go to alumni.cornell.edu/reunion.

Other options to consider:

- Because the university does not allow us to provide babysitting services at class headquarters, we encourage you to bring your own babysitter (who must be 16 or older). Your class may have a special BYOB (Bring Your Own Babysitter) package for the entire weekend.
- The American Red Cross maintains a list of sitters in the Ithaca area who have completed its training program. You may obtain this list by calling 607.273.1900 ext.14. Note: the class has not investigated this service nor the suitability of the people on the list, and due to liability issues we cannot make individual babysitter referrals.

A few notes:

- New York State law prohibits anyone under the age of 21, including infants, from entering the Arts Quad tents in the evenings, even if accompanied by a parent.
- If you are bringing children under the age of 16 to campus, they must be supervised at all times, and you must sign a university release agreement.

A final thought:

You may find yourself limited in your activities and participation in Reunion if you do not arrange for childcare. On the other hand, Reunion is a wonderful time to share your Cornell experience with your entire family. Either way, we'd love to see you all in Ithaca!
