PACKAGE FAQS

What does the registration fee include?

All packages include class receptions and meals, souvenirs, class shuttles, tent parties, headquarters snacks and beverages, and most university events. The University Youth Program, or Ithaca Childcare Program (IC3), some athletic events, and a few ticketed university events are NOT included.

What if I register and then can't come?

We are happy to offer refunds if you cancel before May 27.

Can I register when I get there?

Yes, you can—but please consider that it's much easier on your Reunion team if you sign up beforehand so they order enough food and beverages for the weekend.

HOUSING FAQS

What's included in the room fee?

The university provides bath towels, bed linens, hangers, free wi-fi, and a daily towel exchange. Check our website for items we suggest you bring from home.

When is check in/check out?

Thursday at noon/Sunday by noon.

Can I smoke in the dorms or bring my pet?

No and no (unless your pet is a service animal).

Can I get a room near my friends?

We can try! Although we are unable to pre-assign rooms, you may request to room near someone when you check-in; housing will do their best to accommodate your request.

I have special needs—is it practical for me to stay in the dorms?

Yes! On the registration form, there is a space to communicate your needs. Special requests must be received by May 27.

Does our class have a block of rooms at a hotel?

Yes, although availability is limited as a result of the tremendous response to our Reunion mailing from last fall. Check the class website for details.
